- 5. Review of the draft plan:

As a Parish, we need a broader plan and so suggested the way forward was to pare down our draft NDP into the format suggested and then separately start to put a Parish Plan together; to replace the existing one. The meeting agreed unanimously to this approach and also agreed to assist with the creation of a Parish Plan once the NDP was complete.
 - Trevor had "cut and pasted" from our original draft document and created a first draft based on the new template.
 - The meeting then reviewed the document and Trevor made notes as we went along.

 - It was also noted that we must pay specific attention to the NDP Sustainability Appraisal and explain what we have done to comply within our "light touch" approach – per 3.2 of the draft plan.
